SUCCESSFUL END TO YEAR FOR FIRST EBUSINESS SOLUTIONS

Looking to the future, new contracts secured include two virtualisation projects - one with Aberdeen-based Nautronix giving them state of the art yet cost effective network infrastructure and the other with Highland Metals to implement a cost-effective disaster recovery system.

Gray & Adams, the Fraserburgh-based firm which designs and manufactures freight vehicles has also recently agreed a contract for First eBusiness to implement a new business system using Microsoft Dynamics AX – a system that will support the continued growth of the company's operations.

First eBusiness Solutions Managing Director, Bernard Booker, said: "We have experienced an extremely busy period recently, culminating in the completion of a number of major, long-term projects. The successful completion of these very different contracts, each with its own individual specifications, gives a clear demonstration of the expertise and experience we possess within the company and the diverse range of client's needs that we can service.
